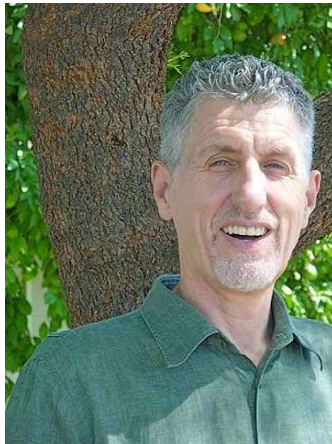
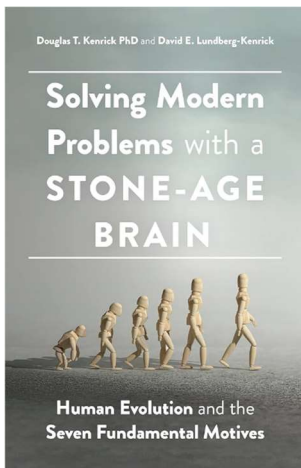


ASU Book Group 2023-2024

Nov. 16 - "Solving Modern Problems with a Stone-Age Brain," by ASU President's Professor Douglas Kenrick and co-author David Lundberg-Kenrick. The focus of this book is "how many of the problems we face in our daily lives stem from the fact that our brains evolved to deal with problems our ancestors faced but that are no longer major factors in our lives," Kenrick says. "Self-driving cars, homes with air conditioning and plush mattresses, and supermarkets stocked with fresh fruit, pre-made meals and some chocolate ice cream for dessert. The hunter-gatherers would probably be shocked to learn that people living amid all of these luxuries are often miserably depressed, anxious and lonely." Kenrick is President's Professor in Psychology and Dave Lundberg-Kenrick is a psychology department program manager.
